ADDENDUM NO. 1

The changes, modifications and/or additions covered by and set forth in this Addendum No. 1 shall become part of and be incorporated in the Specifications, Contract Documents and Bid Documents for the above referenced project.

SPECIFICATIONS

- Section 00410 - Bid Form shall be replaced with the attached.

CLARIFICATION

- The pump/motor assembly on the new Back-Up Well shall be equipped with a Variable Frequency Drive (VFD). The motor for the Back-Up Well shall be inverter duty rated. A VFD will also be installed on the existing production well.
- An interlock shall be installed that will allow only one Well to operate independently. It should be set up so that two wells cannot operate at the same time.
- The existing Production Well recently encountered some issues with their pump and motor assembly. Currently there is a temporary submersible pump installed to provide water to the Mexia Water System. The original plan for this project included the rehabilitation of the old pump and motor. This project will include the installation of a new inverter duty motor and vertical turbine pump. Also, the contractor is responsible for removing the temporary submersible pump and installing another temporary submersible pump that will be a part of this project. This submersible pump will stay in place until the Back-Up Well is up and fully operational. Once the Back-Up Well has been deemed operational, the new pump/motor assembly can be installed.
- Vibration test are required on both the existing Production Well and the New Back-Up Well.

B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the Work.
